Instructions for Scholarship Application

The *California Robbery Investigators Association* scholarship will recognize two outstanding high school seniors who's parent, guardian or grandparent is a current C.R.I.A. member in good standing and who has demonstrated strong moral character and consistent effort to achieve personal potential. Award winners shall have demonstrated a high degree of personal honesty and integrity, a commitment to learning, extracurricular activity; a concern for all members of his or her community; a determination to maximize his or her natural intellectual abilities; and a joy for living life to the fullest. Financial need is not a requirement. Scholarships may include trade schools.

Awards

One \$2,000.00 scholarship award to a high school senior
One \$1,000.00 scholarship award to a high school senior

Qualifications

Scholarships are open for award to any student in the 12th grade at a public or private school whereby the applicant's parent, guardian or grandparent is a member in good standing of the *California Robbery Investigators Association*.

The award is made solely on the basis of merit, without regard to ethnic background, sex, religion or financial need.

How to Apply

1. Fill out the attached application form, completing all questions as concisely as possible.
2. Enclose/Attach to email a transcript of all your high school credits
3. Print and Sign your completed application form on the line provided
4. Have a parent or guardian C.R.I.A. member sign on the line provided
